#### AIMS AND SCOPE

DEVS is a well-known modeling formalism for the description of discrete, continuous and hybrid systems. The methodology is well-founded in mathematical theories and has been efficiently used in many real-world applications.

This track is practical in essence and aims at showing original and timely contributions about real world applications and software support for DEVS, including network, web, cloud, sky, and fog computing technologies. It also looks for contributions related to DEVS in the new areas of model engineering for simulation, DEVS and emergence, Big Data, CPS, and IoT related M&S environments, etc.

A selected group of the best papers of SCSC / DEVS 2017 will be published in a special issue of <u>Complexity</u>. All manuscripts will be subject to the journal's normal process of evaluation for suitability for peer review. Please note that acceptance of a paper in SCSC / DEVS 2017 does not imply acceptance of an accompanying paper for publication in the special issue.
